I am a native Staten Island resident who strongly urges the Advance to advocate for the passage of this much needed peace proposal: the Iran nuclear deal. August 26, 2015, Pasquale Pucella, Prince's Bay To Hon. Senator C.E. Schumer:

With all due respect, I strongly disagree with your position on the Iran agreement. Your reasoning behind your decision to not support this agreement is just a meaningless, self-serving political statement that does not take in consideration the extent of the consequences if we reject this agreement.

You know very well that once we reject this agreement any further negotiation will not be possible: Europe, Russia and China will walk away and they will not support any possible sanctions imposed by the U.S.A. The U.S.A. will be in a weak position in trying to negotiate a better deal with Iran; without any leverage, Iran will not negotiate. The only remaining option for the U.S.A. will be war. War again, Mr. Senator. Do you remember the Iraq war of a decade ago? You were a strong supporter of that too. Where did that leave us?...
